WELCOME, ORGANISERS

The easiest tour your club will ever run

Cooee Tours is a family-owned Queensland touring company, on the road since 1974 – and seniors clubs, retirement villages and community groups are the heart of our year. We know the organiser's job is the hard one: herding the interest list, answering the mobility questions, keeping the treasurer happy. This pack is built to make that job one phone call long.

Every group day is planned around your members, not a fixed brochure: your pick-up point, your pace, your interests, your dates. Comfort stops are mapped roughly every ninety minutes, walking is flat and optional, every guide holds a current first-aid certificate, and wheelchair-accessible vehicles are available on request. You fill the seats – we do everything else.

How it works – five steps

1	Call or email. Tell us your group size, rough dates and what your members enjoy – gardens, heritage, food, a scenic drive. One call: 0409 661 342.
2	We propose the day. Within a few days you get a written itinerary with per-person pricing – built around your venue pick-up, your pace and any mobility needs.
3	Present it to the club. Use this pack and the proposal at your next meeting. We're happy to adjust the plan until it fits.
4	Confirm and collect names. We hold the coach while you firm numbers. Payment arrangements are flexible and agreed at booking – single club invoice or individual payments.
5	Tour day. The coach arrives at your venue, the driver-guide takes it from there, and your only job is accepting the compliments afterwards.

Every tour below runs as a private group charter from your venue, and most also run as scheduled departures your members can join individually. Group rates apply for 10 or more – quoted with your itinerary.

BUILT FOR SENIOR GROUPS

What 'senior-friendly' actually means on our coaches

Fifty years of carrying Queensland's seniors has taught us the difference between a tour that says welcome and one that plans for it. This is what your members can expect on the day.

A different clock	Fewer stops held longer, conveniences roughly every ninety minutes, seated attractions balanced against short flat walks — and no moment in the day where anyone is asked to hurry.
Genuine accessibility	Wheelchair-accessible vehicles with lifts or ramps on request at booking. Walkers and mobility aids stowed and retrieved by the driver at every stop. Flat, sealed paths chosen at every destination.
Care in the background	Every guide holds a current first-aid certificate and carries a full kit. We take emergency contact details for all senior-group guests, and drivers help at the coach step every single time.
Morning tea, done properly	Venues are chosen for seating, easy access and good scones — never a car-park sandwich. On Carnival day tours, morning tea at Picnic Point Lookout is included.
The solo travellers welcome	Clubs always have members who come alone. Coach touring gives them built-in company at morning tea and a table to join at lunch — many of our longest friendships started in a window seat.
Your venue, door to door	We collect from retirement villages, club rooms and community halls across Brisbane, the Gold Coast and the Sunshine Coast — members board where they meet.

FOR THE ORGANISER

Your planning checklist

Have these five things roughly in hand when you call, and we can usually propose your day on the spot.

	HAVE READY	WHY IT HELPS
1	Approximate group size	Coach size and group rate both hinge on it — 10+ unlocks group pricing
2	Two or three possible dates	Midweek dates often have better availability; Carnival weekends book out months ahead
3	Pick-up point	Your village, club rooms or hall — we come to you
4	Mobility notes	Wheelchairs, walkers, or members who tire in the afternoon — the earlier we know, the better the plan
5	Budget per head	Tell us the treasurer's number and we design to it, not past it

Good to know

Holding seats. We hold the coach while you confirm numbers with members — timeframes agreed when we propose the day. Payment. Flexible and agreed at booking: a single club invoice or individual member payments both work. Weather. Every itinerary carries an indoor fallback, so the day survives a shower. Terms. Full booking conditions at cooeetours.com.au/legal/terms.html.

The September rule

If your club wants the Carnival of Flowers, decide early. Festival-season coaches — especially the parade weekend (19–20 September) and FEASTival weekend (26–27 September) — are the first to sell out every year. A June or July committee decision books comfortably; an August one takes what's left.
